- Business Ethics. CA&I will promote:

 - o Respect towards all employees, stakeholders and the community
 - o Anti-bribery and anti-corruption practices
- Protecting People. CA&I will ensure:
 - o Risk the health and safety of employees, stakeholders and the community
 - o To avoid practices that will have a negative impact on local and indigenous people
 - o Support for diversity and inclusion
- Human Rights. CA&I;
 - o Is committed to equal opportunity and application of fair labour practices.
 - o Will ensure that our activities do not directly or indirectly violate human rights in any country (eg forced labour)

Proactiveness

- Donations and Aid. Our Company will aim to preserve a budget to make monetary contributions / donations to:
 - o Advance the arts, education and community events
 - o Alleviate those in need
- Volunteering. Our company will encourage its employees to volunteer. They can volunteer through programs organised internally or externally.
